We have already begun to plan for next year's show, which we will be performing at home football games, area festivals, MSBOA district festival, invitationals and competitions. **Practice and preparation will be the two most important factors in obtaining the skills needed to perform well.**

Marching Band Camp provides the opportunity for us to polish our skills and address the pressing issue of learning the show. It is at Band Camp where we "put it all together" with hard work, and fun. At no other time during the season will we have the privilege of having so many rehearsals in such a short time span. As you can see, the success of marching band camp foretells the success of the band for the entire year.

For those of you who are new members of the band: Band Camp also provides us the opportunity to get to know one another. We work very hard at learning our show and being a great band, but we also work hard at having fun and becoming a caring responsible group of musicians. Lincoln Lake Camp has many activities for students to enjoy during their free time including water skiing and swimming. We will also be adding a variety of group activities to this year's schedule to help us all grow as leaders in the school and band.

We are pleased to announce that we have been able to maintain the pricing from previous years! Thanks to our boosters efforts in fundraising and budgeting Camp will only cost \$300.00 this year, and can be paid in installments.

Pre-Camp/Camp:

Pre-Band Camp, and Band Camp are two vital components of our year. Pre-Camp allows us to focus on the basics of Marching and Music. This 4-day period gives us the opportunity to introduce ourselves to our new members and teach them the marching and musical basics that we all must have to be successful at Band Camp. Pre-Camp takes place in the Caledonia High School Band Room, and our practice field.

Band Camp Takes place at Lincoln Lake Baptist Camp in Gowen, Michigan. **Band Camp is a required activity for all students participating in the Caledonia High School Band Program.** Band Camp is an integral part of the high school band music curriculum. Students will return from camp having learned the necessary skills and a major portion of the fall marching program. The band performs, often before the official start of school. The camp routine from check-in through the exit performance is important. Requests to come late or leave early conflict with the successful operation of the camp. **The camp requirement is for the entire camp week.**

Band Camp is a positive, historical, yet required aspect of the Caledonia High School Band. Therefore, financial need shall not be a reason for a student not participating. Cases of real and verifiable need should be directed to the directors and band boosters so that we can help you.

Instruments:

Please make sure that your instrument is in proper working condition before the start of Camp in July. Please contact the directors if you have questions regarding the conditions of your instrument. Marching Instruments may be checked out at the end of the 2011 school year.

Music:

Music will be available to you as you come to pre-camp. Most of the music should be completed by summer vacation. Students will receive their music as soon as it is done.

Health Forms/Permission Slips:

All health forms and travel permission slips must be turned in prior to or during the pre-camp parent meeting on July 21, 2011. These forms are required for your student to travel with the band to camp and other competitions. **ALL INFORMATION ON THESE FORMS IS KEPT CONFIDENTIAL.**

Rehearsals/schedule:

See the attached calendar for all dates and times of rehearsals, competitions, games, and other events. We have very little time to accomplish many tasks. Because of this, it is essential to the success of the group that each student is ready to play at the start time listed on the calendar. If the event starts at 7:00 please be early to get your instrument and other supplies in order. We cannot afford to lose time waiting for stragglers.

“Early is on time, and on time is late!”

Uniforms:

The Caledonia High School Marching Band has two uniforms for the season. The Summer Uniforms consists of our 2011 t-shirt, which students will receive during 4th of July parade rehearsals. Along with the t-shirt students will wear Khaki shorts, and tennis shoes.

The marching uniform consists of the following items which will be fitted to students individually during the summer: Bibs, Jacket, Sash, Shako, Plume. Students must provide the following items, which will be available for purchase during fitting: Uniform shoes, Black socks, Gloves, White t-shirt or Summer Uniform shirt (for under jacket).

Students who do not have the proper uniform pieces at a performance will NOT participate in the performance. Sections leaders, staff, and directors, will inspect all uniforms prior to a performance to assure that we all have the correct uniform.

Our Concert Uniforms consist of tuxedos for men and black dresses for women. These uniforms will also be fitted during summer uniform fitting.

All uniforms will be kept at the school. Prior to a performance, students will check out their uniform. When finished with it a band parent will inspect and return the uniform to its location in the uniform room.

Standards and Expectations:

Members of the Caledonia High School Band are held to the highest musical and behavioral standards. Every student is expected to give 100% of their effort in all areas. All students will follow the rules and regulations stated in the Caledonia High School Student Handbook and those put in place by the Lincoln Lake Baptist Camp.

All students will follow the rules regarding curfew and lights out at night, and the rules regarding students in rooms. (no boys in girls rooms, and no girls in boys rooms) Violation of any of the attached rules, those found in the CHS Handbook, or those stated by Lincoln Lake Baptist Camp may result in disciplinary action as stated in the CHS Handbook. Actions can lead up to and include parent notification of the event, and the parents arranging, at their expense, the immediate transportation home of their child. Failure to follow the rules may also jeopardize the students' future participation in the CHS Band Program, and depending on the infraction, notification of school or state authorities for further disciplinary action.

The CHS Bands have a reputation of respect and responsibility. We have a great group of students and parents who will make sure that we continue this fine tradition of excellence.
